Vegetation: bamboo forests, cedar, oak, maple.

Flora: Rose, carnations, jasmin, tuberose, jonquil; also a plant called "bougna-géné-mauro" in the vernacular, which I can't translate.

Found particularly round Makasar, it resembles the lily.
